HISTORY

Kedron Lions takes pride in its history and core values. Steeped in history dating back to 1937, Kedron Lions is one of AFL's oldest clubs. The clubs formation was the result of an amalgamation between Kedron and Wooloowin Past Pupil's Associations and are still to this day affectionately knowns as the 'Regleggers'.

Red Legger, Erwin Dornau (below), was the first Queenslander to play in the AFL/VFL, making his debut in 1948. He was a local Windsor State Primary School student and at just 13 years of age was selected to represent QLD interstate.

The sports ground is named after E K (Ted) Anderson, who helped build the family club, pictured in the 1950 team (below, front center) with his son seated at his feet holding the football. With a rich history of success, Kedron Lions have won multiple premierships across all competitions and proudly produced many champion representative players, including six Grogan Medallists and ten AFL Queensland Hall of Fame players.


